

# **April Moore Honorary Scholarship**

Chapa-De Indian Health is honored to offer a \$1,000 scholarship in recognition of our long-time Board President April Moore. April has dedicated her life to advancing American Indian people and has served on the Chapa-De Board of Directors for 26 years. During her time on our Board, April has ensured that our clinics have offered high-quality healthcare to native and low-income community members.

We are pleased to offer this annual scholarship to American Indian students who plan to pursue a career in healthcare. This will be an annual scholarship with a new recipient selected each year from applicants who attended high school in Placer, Nevada, Sacramento or Sierra Counties in California.

## To qualify, applicants must;

- Be a graduating high school senior or 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year college student
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Be American Indian/Alaskan Native (for the purpose of this scholarship this is defined as being eligible for services at Indian Health Service Clinics)
- Plan to pursue vocational training or a college degree in a healthcare related field
- Have attended high school in Nevada, Placer, Sacramento or Sierra County in California
- Submit all required application materials by the submission deadline

## **Application Submission Requirements**

- April Moore Honorary Scholarship Application Form
- Two letters of recommendation
- Official school transcript(s) High School and Secondary School if applicable
- Proof of Al/AN heritage

#### **Selection Process & Award Requirements**

- Chapa-De's Board of Directors will select and notify the winning applicant
- Proof of college enrollment is required before receiving the scholarship funds
- An alternate scholar will be chosen if the original scholarship recipient is unable to fulfill the scholarship conditions
